What to Do When People Start Fighting?**

The dividing line between the post-death administration and litigation of a trust or estate is not always clear. This program will identify red flags signaling that contested court proceedings are likely on the horizon, pre-litigation actions that may avoid disputes and actions that should be taken if litigation erupts. Included in this discussion will be the real issues driving almost all probate litigation, common mistakes made by fiduciaries, the often misunderstood limits of the attorney-client privilege in this context, and key issues to identify once the litigation process is underway.
